Abraham Joseph BÜHLER circa 1779 Kleinerdlingen - 24 January 1855 in Kleinerdlingen., occupation: horse trader, married about 1805 Rachel/Regine daughter of Elias Sandel later Lauchheimer (born around 1784 in Kleinerdlingen - 20 February 1849 in Kleinerdlingen. Both buried in Wallerstein cemetery.

2)Abraham BÜHLER/ Buehler 2 May 1859 Kleinerdingen – 21 August 1948 New York, married 12 August 1889 in Würzburg to Bertha ADLER 11 February 1860 Markelsheim – 11 April 1947 New York, New York (name changed to Buehler in the United States) Abraham was a leather dealer in Noerdlingen. The family lived on 30 Judengasse in Noerdlingen. Abraham and Bertha came to America in December 1938 with their daughter Lina Buehler Levi and her husband Max Levi aboard the Nieuw Amsterdam. They lived with Lina and Max in Washington Heights, Manhattan, New York for the rest of their lives. Abraham and Bertha are buried in Mount Ararat Cemetery in Farmingdale, New York.

Abraham and Bertha Buehler's children:

a) Jakob BÜHLER 29 July 1890 Nördlingen – 11 July 1916

Souville France (World War I)(JAKOB BUHLER (September 27, 1890 - 11 Jul 1916) Kaufmann in Nördlingen, son of Abraham Buhler leather merchant in Nördlingen Hunters in the Infantry Regiment 3 of the German Alpine Corps convened on Feb 8, 1915 fell on July 11, 1916 at assault on the fort Souville of Verdun, fatal injury by shrapnel, grave unknown (Volume II, page 121) <http://www.alemannia-judaica.de/images/Images%20Bayern/Soldaten%20Noerdlingen%20WWI.htm> )

c) Betty BÜHLER (twin of Lina.) 24 September 1893 Nördlingen – 27 September 1894 Nördlingen

d) Lina BÜHLER/ BUEHLER (twin of Betty.) 24 September 1893 Nördlingen – 5 December 1894 in Brevard County FL, married 18 March 1923 Nördlingen to Max LEVI (10 September 1889 Markt Berolzheim – 28 November 1960 ; New York City, New York) Max was businessman in Markt Berolzheim and then Nürnberg. He had 2 businesses Beroli and Automatin Dienst. He was a World War 1 veteran, having been a prisoner in France for 4 years. Max and Lina and their two children (and her parents) came to America in December 1938 aboard the Nieuw Amsterdam. In 1963 Lina moved to Titusville, Brevard County, Florida with her daughter Margot and Margot's family. Lina and Max are buried in Cedar Park/Beth El Cemetery in Paramus, New Jersey

Margot LEVI (22 July 1925 Markt Berolzheim - living) married 19 October 1946 in Miami, Florida to Werner HERZ (18 October 1925 in Kamen, Germany - 11 February 2002 Titusville, Florida,) Werner was a businessman. Margot worked as a bookkeeper in New York before her children were born. The family moved to New Jersey after daughter Linda was born. After the family moved to Titusville, Florida in 1963 Margot and Werner ran several businesses together. When the family moved to Florida they brought both of their widowed mothers with them. Lives in Titusville, Florida.

Leo LEVI (17 April 1927 Markt Berolzheim, Germany – 28 December 2001 Fonda NY, statistician, married Violet KISTER HEAVNER 17 August 1957 (born 6 February 1916, died 19 December 1987) Married Reva Briggs in Broward County, Florida in 1993. Leo served in the United States Navy during WW11.

e)Gustav BÜHLER/BUEHLER 30 December 1894 Nördlingen – 24 August 1964 Brooklyn NY, ( leather handbag manufacturer) married 14 October 1926 to Bertha TUTEUR (1899-1983) Gus came to America in the 1920s . He and his brother Max were able to sponsor Abraham and Bertha Buehler and all of their children to come to America. Gus and Bertha are buried in Mount Ararat Cemetery in Farmingdale, New York.

Emilie (Millie) BÜHLER/BUEHLER (13 May 1896 Nördlingen – 14 December 1991 North Carolina, married 1 March 1926 in Ansbach to Abraham (Albert) FRÖHLICH (21 January 1895 Thüngen – 26 February 1977 Raleigh NC) Abraham settled in Noerdlingen after marrying Emilie. He was known as Albert in the Buehler family, as Emilie “Millie” felt having two Abraham’s in the family would be confusing. Albert worked with his father in law in the leather business. Millie and Albert came to America in December 1938. They were sponsored by her brother Max Buehler who came to America in the 1920s. They lived in New York City until 1977 when their

daughter Anneliese “Anne” moved them to be near her in Raleigh, North Carolina.

Anneliese FRÖHLICH (8 August 1927 Nördlingen - Living) married 28 August 1948 married Harry SHEARER 28 August 1948 (owned dress shop : “Shearers”) recently celebrated their 65th anniversary in 2013. “Anne” and her husband Harry lived most of their married lives in Raleigh, North Carolina. They moved circa 2010 to Miami, Florida to be closer to their daughter Barbara, who lives in Miami, and son Ron who also lives in Florida.
