FRIEDRICH KAULLA (born as Salomon Friedrich ?)

banker in Stuttgart, until 1838 owner of land estate Theurers Hof + castle near Schwaebisch Hall, since 1851 owner of land estate + castle Oberdischingen (bought from Ludwig Anton Graf Schenk von Castell), since 1872 owner of "Gutsherrschaftliche Bierbrauerei Friedrich Kaulla" converted on 01 Sep 1892 from Jewry to Protestantism at church in Ersingen

born 22 Jul 1807 Hechingen, died 06 Jan 1895 Oberdischingen
parents = Wolf von Kaulla 1768 Hechingen - 1841 Stuttgart + Eva nee Bing
1777-1837 (Wolf was a son auf Madame Kaulla + Akiba Auerbacher)

married 05 Dec 1837

LOUISE PFEIFFER

born 26 Jan 1820 Stuttgart, died 06 Jul 1888 Oberdischingen parents = Court Jew Marx Pfeiffer + 2nd wife Dorothee (Tolz) nee Kaulla (Dorothee was a daughter of Wolf von Kaulla)

Salomon Friedrich + Louise Kaulla were buried at Oberdischingen cemetery - their vault was destroyed in 1976 - a memorial plaque reminds of them

parents = Moritz Marx Hohenemser
+ wife Sophie nee Loewengard

couple was buried in Frankfurt-am-Main

son Paul Hohenemser 1869-1932 was librarian

and historian in Frankfurt-am-Main

May 1842 - 22 Apr 1843 Stuttgart

(03) PAULA LUISE

FRIEDERIKE MATHILDE

07 Aug 1843 - ? (lived 1912 in Ulm)

married 28 Jan 1872 at Oberdischingen castle

OSKAR VON SARWEY from Ludwigsburg

high ranking Officer of Wuerttemberg Army (took part in War auf 1870/71 with France) + pioneer partner in Roman Limes archaeology since 1890 living in Charlottenburg (Berlin) 07 Mar 1837 - 30 Jan 1912 Berlin-Charlottenburg

parents = Gottfried August von Sarwey +

wife Louise nee Ulmer (both died in Stuttgart)

couple had a son Otto von Sarwey * 18 Mat 1879

(04) HERMANN MICHAEL

29 Sep 1844 - 17 Mar 1882 Meran (Italy)

joint owner with father of Oberdischingen estate

died on a cure, buried in Oberdischingen
at Catholic community cemetery
married 28 October 1880
EUGENIE JENNY MAYER from Vienna (Austria)
20 Aug 1861 - ?
parents = Franz Mayer + wife Leonie

EUGENIE JENNY as a widow married

ALOIS VON HAUPTMANN

Lieutenant - Field Marshal at Austrian Army ca 1835 - 28 Sep 1914 parents = Johann Michael Hauptmann + wife Franziska

(05) CLARA MARIA CATHARINA

20 Nov 1845 - 01 Sep 1911 Weimar - buried in Ulm converted from Jewry to Protestantism in 1878 married 03 Oct 1880 at Oberdischingen Castle LUDWIG HEINRICH EBERS from Berlin started career as captain of Prussian Army, then owned Dolgenbrodt land estate near Berlin, after 1871 partner of FLORA landspeculation in Berlin-Charlottenburg together with JAW Carstenn and finally manager of Oberdischingen land estate before moving to Ulm around 1895

17 Sep 1835 Berlin - 29 Dec 1901 Ulm parents = banker + manufacturer Georg Moritz Ebers 22 Apr 1802 - 14 Feb 1837 + wife Franziska (born Fanny) nee Levysohn 25 Jul 1802 - 1886

Georg Moritz Ebers was born Jewish as Meier Moses Ephraim and changed name when he converted to Protestantism in 1826. He was a grandson of famous Nathan Veitel Heine Ephraim, Court jeweller and banker for Friedrich der Grosse in Prussia – his residence "Ephraim Palace" still exists as an important landmark in Berlin.

Munich New Pinakotek has an oil painting of Ludwig Eber's mother **Fanny Ebers** (born in Rotterdam), created in 1826 in connection with Ludwig's + Fanny's marriage by famous painter Friedrich Wilhelm Schadow right before he moved from Berlin to Duesseldorf where he became director of the academy of arts, replacing Peter Cornelius who had moved to Munich.
