## ISAK ALEXANDER

mater weaver in Hengstfeld, since 1867 in Stuttgart as experienced dealer  
of antiques, since 1885 in Noerdlingen, where his daughter lived  
born 14 (or 10 ?) Jul 1811 Hengstfeld, died 22 Apr 1892 Noerdlingen  
(parents = Alexander/called Sender + wife Sara nee Eichberg) (A)

married (1) 1 Nov 1837 in Hengstfeld

## BREINDEL KAHN

born 1 Nov 1813 Duensbach, died 19 Jan 1838 Hengstfeld  
(parents = Loew Kahn + wife Lea)

married (2) 4 Sep 1838 in Hengstbach

## THERESE NEUMANN

born 6 Oct 1820 (?) Lauchheim, died ?  
(parents = Hirsch Neumann + wife Heffel nee David)

## CHILDREN (all born in Hengstfeld):

- (01) REBEKA (Rika) 25 Aug 1839 - 06 Apr 1896  
(died in Tarboro, North Carolina USA)  
emigrated to North America in 1859  
married 9 Dec 1859 in Richmond, Virginia  
(B) Koppel Feldenheimer (born 12 Jun 1828 Hengstfeld,  
died 21 Feb 1906 Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania USA ?)
- (02) JETTE 23 May 1841 - ? (went to America in 1858 ?)  
returned to Germany, lived in Noerdlingen  
supported by sister Sara, died 16 Feb 1914  
(grave B-3-02 Jewish cemetery Noerdlingen)
- (03) SIMON SENDER 02 Feb 1843 - ? (went to America in 1856 ?)
- (04) EVA 25 Nov 1844 - ? (went to England in 1862 ?)
- (05) LOEW HIRSCH 17 Oct 1846 - ? (went to America in 1864 ?)  
he returned to Germany and died in Stuttgart  
05 Jul 1880 (buried at Prag cemetery)
- (06) HAEHNLEIN 11 Jan 1849 - ? (went to America in 1866 ?)  
(called Henry) settled in Joliet, Illinois USA ?  
married Anneta (born in Germany) ?  
3 kids ? = Bertha 1877, Sigmund 1880, Adele 1882  
(this speculation according to USA 1870 census)
- (07) FRADEL 11 Feb 1851 - 13 Aug 1885 (went 1864 ? to America)  
(called Fanny) (died in Tarboro, Edgecombe, North Carolina USA)  
(C) married in 1870 Lazarus/Louis Heilbronner  
(6 Oct 1845 Binswangen - 18 Jun 1915 New York)  
couple had seven children, all born in Tarboro:

Abraham 1870, Alexander 1872, Therese 1873,  
Gaston 1876, Lawrence 1878, Julia 1879,  
Sadie 1882

- (08) RUBEN  
(called Robert) 02 Mar 1853 - ? (went to America in 1870 ?)  
settled in Joliet, Illinois USA ?
- (09) KEHLE (Karoline) 14 Apr 1855 - ? (probably married NN Rothschild  
in Chicago ?)
- (10) SARA (first twin) 09 Aug 1858 - 7 Mar 1923 (died in Noerdlingen)  
married 6 Nov 1878 in Tarboro, North Carolina USA  
David Sternglanz from Ederheim  
(10 Feb 1854 - 13 Feb 1930)  
grave B-3-26 Jewish cemetery Noerdlingen  
couple had lived for some time in the USA,  
but had returned to Germany by 1883  
(see own family sheet)
- (11) JUETLE (second twin) 09 Aug 1858 - ?  
(called Julie) married 5 Nov 1875 Abraham Isaac Heilbronner  
(probably in Wilson, North Carolina USA),  
her son = Louis Heilbronner in Wilson

(A) father Alexander Hirsch (born ca 1779 in Moenchsdeggingen as son of Isaak and Rebeka, died 17 Sep 1826 Hengstfeld) had moved to Hengstfeld and married ca 1810 Sara Eichberg of Hengstfeld (12 Aug 1786 - 8 Nov 1856, her father was Isak Eichberg)

(B) Koppel Feldenheimer went to North America in 1854 with his mother. The children of Koppel and Rebeka Feldenheimer were (born in Tarboro): Sadie 1 Mar 1863 - 4 Feb 1916, David born 18 Mar 1864, Samuel 25 Jul 1867 - 9 Oct 1927, Joseph 29 Sep 1869 - 1924) they all died in Philadelphia (probably Pittsburgh)

(C) Louis Heilbronner's parents in Binswangen were Loeb Lazarus Heilbronner and his wife Rachel (Regina) nee Thannhauser
