marble factory owner in Noerdlingen with brother Emil (Max Koppel & Sons)
born 12 Oct 1873 Kleinerdlingen, died 3 May 1934 Noerdlingen
(parents = stone mason Max Koppel + wife Peppi nee Neuburger)

married 28 Oct 1900 in Munich

JENNY WASSERMANN

born 25 Jul 1879 Munich, died 1935 (in Hamburg) buried in Noerdlingen (A)
(parents = horse dealer Aron Wassermann + wife Babette nee Fromm) (B)

| (01) JUSTIN | 29 Aug 1902 - 29 Sep 1960
(died in Los Angeles USA) moved to Munich
around 1920, later emigrated to Puerto de la Cruz
(Tenerife, Canary Islands) and finally USA |
| (02) NORBERT | 21 Feb 1905 - ? (moved to Munich around 1921,
later to Hamburg, Abendrotweg 71/III, where he
worked as a musician and had his own music
publishing company - he then emigrated to
Buenos Aires, played accordeon, had a Tango
Orchestra and a Radio Show, produced records |
| (03) KURT | 10 May 1908 - 1970 (Tenerife, Canary Islands)
(moved to Munich around 1924,
later emigrated to Santa Cruz de Tenerife
(Canary Islands), where he married Irene Modolell |
| (04) BRUNO | 26 Mar 1912 - 26 Sep 1914 (died in Noerdlingen) |

(A) Jenny Koppel must have lived with her son Norbert in Hamburg since 1934 and probably died there in 1935.

(B) Aron Wassermann was born 7 Jan 1846 in Aufhausen and died 4 Dec 1915 in Munich. He married ca 1871 Peppi (Babette) Fromm (born 25 May 1850 in Fischach, died 27 Sep 1907 in Munich). Couple lived in Munich since 1875 and had eight children altogether, five of them survived childhood.
